## COTSEN UNDERGRADUATE RESEARCH GRANT APPLICATION

**Purpose:** The Cotsen Institute of Archaeology will award fellowships for \$1000 each to select UCLA undergraduate students in good standing to work on an archaeological project with a UCLA professor. This is a competitive program. Students will be evaluated based upon overall academic excellence and commitment to scientific field research. The fellowship holder is expected to use the fellowship to defray costs to attend a research project with a UCLA professor, but some exceptions to the off-campus rule may be permitted.

**Eligibility:** Undergraduate students from any departments on campus are eligible, so long as they are in good academic standing. Students not preparing for a career in archaeology are also urged to apply.
