

COTSEN UNDERGRADUATE RESEARCH GRANT APPLICATION

Purpose: The Cotsen Institute of Archaeology offers fellowships for undergraduate students who are involved in an archaeological field school or research project either with a UCLA professor or UCLA graduate student or an outside university or academic non-profit. Preference will be given for UCLA based projects. This is a competitive program in which students will be evaluated upon overall academic excellence and commitment to field research. The fellowship is meant to defray costs of participation in an archaeological project, but some exceptions to the off-campus rule may be permitted.

Eligibility: Undergraduate students from any department on campus are eligible, so long as they are in good academic standing. Students not preparing for a career in archaeology are also urged to apply.
